- Operate forklift equipment to transport materials throughout the warehouse.
- Accurately pick and count product from storage locations for production.
- Put away finished or raw materials into designated storage locations.
- Utilize handheld RF scanners and warehouse management systems to complete daily transactions and maintain inventory accuracy.
- Support the palletization, preparation, and staging of finished goods pallets to meet customer and shipping requirements.
- Organize finished goods pallets by customer and shipment requirements; accurately measure, weigh, and record pallet dimensions and shipment information to support transportation planning and ensure a smooth handoff to the Shipping department.
