- Lead the implementation, optimization, and continuous support of Manufacturing Execution System (MES) solutions, ensuring effective deployment, user adoption, system utilization, data integrity, and alignment with manufacturing and business requirements.
- Collaborate cross-functionally with Operations, Quality, Maintenance, Supply Chain, and other stakeholders to drive process excellence, operational performance, and successful execution of strategic initiatives.
