 - Tracking vulnerability mitigation implementation
 - Maintaining CMDBs data quality

- Manage and track migrations of obsolete operating systems (e.g. Windows Server 2012, 2016 etc.).
- Integrate and analyze data from Excel, CSV, SharePoint, databases and Power BI.
- Generate automated and personalized bulk communications to application owners.
- Design, implement, maintain dashboards and reports on CMDBs health, lifecycle compliance, migration status etc.
