and provide information / data for corrective actions. Monitor Production line data (SPC) to focus and prioritize

2) Utilize data monitoring tools to highlight analysis priorities.

4) Develop and maintain current knowledge / information (as necessary) on product and station drawings, specifications, etc...

5) Document findings into individual reports and/or trend information.

6) Work with Sr. Quality Engineer (Jidoka), QAP and FA Operators to establish optimized Production line analysis strategy and support accordingly (Jidoka meetings, training...).

7) Support Plant and Worldwide meetings as needed (Fast response, Jidoka, Internal Defect Management, Scrap Reduction, etc...)

8) Plan and carry out special studies as needed to lower NOK & reject rates or gather data for changes to the process or product.

9) Maintain testing and analysis equipment, perform calibration activities.
